THURSDAY, OCTOBER 8 | CENTRAL MEDITERRANEAN COAST / JEZREEL VALLEY / SEA OF GALILEE

Get to know your fellow travelers while heading north along the Mediterranean shore through the lush Jezreel Valley to the Sea of Galilee. Encounter God on Mt. Carmel and look over the beautiful Valley of Armageddon as you contemplate biblical prophecy (Megiddo). Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

Caesarea Maritima

- View extensive ruins of an ancient port city built by King Herod and seat of the Roman governors (Acts 12:19)
- Peter proclaimed the Good News to the Roman centurion at Caesarea Maritima (Acts 10:23-26)

Mt. Carmel

■ Elijah prayed at Mt. Carmel and God defeated 450 prophets of Baal with fire from heaven (1 Kings 18)

Megiddo (Valley of Armageddon)

- Site of the final battle (between the forces of good and evil), synonymous with Armageddon (Revelation 16:16)
- A major city-state in the ancient Near East was conquered and rebuilt many times (Joshua 5:19, 2 Kings 23:29)

Nazareth Village

■ An open-air Galilean village museum recreating life during the time of Christ

Mt. Precipice

■ Tradition says Jesus disappeared in the crowd at Mt. Precipice after being chased out of the synagogue in Nazareth (Luke 4:16-30)

Tiberias (Sea of Galilee)

■ The area of key events in Jesus' ministry











FRIDAY, OCTOBER 9 | SEA OF GALILEE / GOLAN HEIGHTS / JORDAN RIVER (BAPTISMS)

Wake up to a sunrise on the Sea of Galilee, where Jesus walked on water and calmed the storm. Follow Jesus along the shore as well as into the Golan Heights learning what He taught His disciples. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

Caesarea Philippi (Banias)

- Where Jesus asked His disciples, "Who do men say that I am?" with opportunity to reflect on the same question (Mark 8:27-30)
- Historical significance as a center of pagan worship during biblical times

Tel Dan Nature Reserve

- Named for the Tribe of Dan, one of the twelve tribes of Israel (Joshua 19:40)
- Immerse in the natural beauty of the reserve, which features lush vegetation and flowing streams

Mt. of Beatitudes

■ Take time for spiritual reflection and meditation on Jesus' teachings from the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5:1-15)

Capernaum

- Base of Jesus' early ministry (Matthew 4:13, Luke 4:31) and site of many healings (Mark 1:31-38)
- Home of Simon Peter (Mark 1:21, 29)

Sea of Galilee Boat Ride

- Board a replica "Jesus Boat," the same kind of fishing boat used by the disciples of Jesus for a ride on the Sea of Galilee)
- Visit the Boat Museum and view a fishing boat from time of Jesus discovered in 1986

Yardenit for Baptisms

■ Participants will have the opportunity to experience baptism in the Jordan River (Note: White robes must be worn over clothing or swimsuits for baptisms. Robe and towel are rented on-site for a minimal fee.)

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 10 | JUDEAN WILDERNESS / JERUSALEM

Before leaving the Galilee, enjoy a time of reflection from a panoramic viewpoint. Continue the day's journey traveling through the Judean wilderness passing by Jericho. Ascend to the majestic city of Jerusalem! Dinner and overnight at the Jerusalem. (Note: Hotel check-in could be late due to Shabbat.)

Mt. Arbel


■ Enjoy a short hike to see an incredible panoramic view of the Sea of Galilee before leaving this area

Beit She'an

■ Known for its historical significance, including the poignant site where the bodies of King Saul and his sons were hung from the city walls after their defeat by the Philistines (1 Samuel 31:10-12).

Israel Museum

- Marvel at the Shrine of the Book, housing the Dead Sea Scrolls and providing insights into ancient Jewish life
- Explore the 1:50 scale model of Jerusalem, depicting the city as it would have appeared during during the time of Jesus.









SUNDAY, OCTOBER 11 | JERUSALEM

Jerusalem! Jerusalem! Lift up your gates and sing, Hosanna in the highest, Hosanna to the King! Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Mt. of Olives

- Stand on the beautiful Mt. of Olives to behold the breathtaking panorama of the Holy City
- Gaze at the gate Jesus will walk through when He returns

Palm Sunday Road and Garden of Gethsemane

- Sing Hosanna as you descend down Palm Sunday Road to the Garden of Gethsemane with its ancient olive trees (Luke 22:39-44, Matthew 21:1-11, 26:36-53, John 18:1)
- Pray in the Garden of Gethsemane just as Jesus prayed on the night of His betrayal

Pools of Bethesda

- Where Jesus healed a cripple (John 5:2-15_
- Explore St. Anne's Crusader Church, renowned for its magnificent acoustics

The Pavement and Via Dolorosa

- Visit the Pavement, where Jesus stood while being tried by Pilate
- Follow the Via Dolorosa, retracing the steps of Jesus, culminating in a visit to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher
- View the Ecce Homo Arch, a Roman-era triumphal arch in Jerusalem that marks a traditional site on the Via Dolorosa

Church of the Holy Sepulcher

■ According to traditions, the church contains both the site where Jesus was crucified and the empty tomb where he was buried and resurrected.

Western Wall and Western Wall Tunnel (time permitting)

- Approach this sacred site where Jews gather for prayer, with the opportunity to tour the Western Wall Tunnel
- Walk through the Western Wall Tunnel and see the area believed to be the closest to the Holy of Holies

Southern Steps

■ Steps to the Second Temple main entrance during the time of Jesus, and it is believed that he and his disciples walked


Upper Room and King David's tomb (time permitting)

- Believed to be the location of where Jesus shared the Last Supper with his disciples
- Tomb of King David on Mt. Zion, revered as one of the most holiest places for the Jewish people











MONDAY, OCTOBER 12 | DEAD SEA

Journeying through the desert by the Dead Sea offers captivating sights of arid landscapes, date palm groves, salt formations, and rugged mountains. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Masada Fortress


- Formidable fortress constructed by King Herod and site of the last Jewish resistance against the Romans in 73 AD
- Ascend Masada by cable car, granting panoramic views of the surrounding landscape
- Survey the extensive ruins of Masada, including fortifications, waterworks, a synagogue, temples, and palaces


Ein Gedi

- Explore the serene beauty of Ein Gedi, an oasis nestled in the desert landscape
- Explore the area where David penned many of the Psalms and sought refuge from King Saul (1 Samuel 24:1-7)

Qumran

- Take a brief stop where the ancient Dead Sea scrolls were authored over 2000 years ago and discovered in 1947 Float in the Dead Sea
- Bring a swimsuit, towel (from the hotel) and water shoes at the bottom surface can be rough











TUESDAY, OCTOBER 13 | JERUSALEM / BETHLEHEM

Continue to revel in the sights, sounds and tastes of the Holy City. End the pilgrimage in Israel with a time of quiet reflection, worship, and communion at the Garden Tomb. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Bethlehem and Shepherd's Field

- Visit the Church of the Nativity, marking the sacred birthplace of Jesus
- Explore Shepherd's Field where the angelic announcement of Jesus' birth was made to the shepherds

City of David

■ Explore the excellent archaeological remains from David's period and the Kings of Judah (2 Samuel 5:8-10)

Hezekiah's Tunnel and Pool of Siloam

- Walk through Hezekiah's Tunnel, a 2,700-year-old water tunnel constructed during the reign of King Hezekiah potentially getting wet (2 Chronicles 32:30) Bring a flashlight and water shoes should you choose to walk the "wet" tunnel
- Emerge at the historic Pool of Siloam, where Jesus healed the blind man (John 9:1-12)

Garden Tomb

■ Take time for quiet contemplation, reflection, and worship amidst the spiritual significance of the serene surroundings


WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 14 | ROME, ITALY

- See San Pietro in Vincoli, built in the 5th century Ad by Pope Sixtus III to house the chains that bound Peter when he was imprisoned in Jerusalem. Also the site of Michelangelo's famous statue of Moses.
- View the Trevi Fountain, built in the 1700's and treasured as one of Rome's most iconic structures

FRIDAY, OCTOBER 16 | ROME

Take in the magnificence of Rome today visiting ancient sights and being immersed in the vibrancy of this overwhelming city! Overnight in Rome.

Vatican City

- Smallest independent state in world—home to the Pope, the spiritual leader of the Roman Catholic Church
- See the Vatican Museum's extensive collection of art from ancient Egyptian artifacts to Renaissance masterpieces
- Be amazed at the Sistine Chapel, famous for its ceiling painted by Michelangelo, depicting scenes from the Book of Genesis, as well as the Last Judgment on the altar wall
- Visit St. Peter's Basilica, the largest church in the world overlooking the enormous Piazza San Pietro, and believed to be the burial place of Saint Peter, one of the twelve apostles of Jesus and the first Bishop of Rome
- Admire St. Peter's Square, famous for its colonnades designed by Bernini and is a gathering place for papal events

St. Paul's Outside the Walls

- One of four major basilicas in Rome located and located outside of ancient city walls
- Dedicated to St. Paul the Apostle and believed to be built over his burial site

Catacombs

- Explore tunnels and see the carvings on the walls from early Christians
- Provided a place for burials and religious rituals away from persecution

CANCELLATION POLICY

- Any individual canceling between the date of registration and the Final Payment Due Date (Final Payment Due Date is 100 days prior to the tour departure date) will be
 penalized a non-refundable \$500 per person deposit and non-transferable administrative cost plus any non-refundable third-party supplier cost/s.
- Any individual canceling between 99 85 days prior to the scheduled departure date we will be penalized the entire tour deposit plus 10% of the total tour cost and any
